## **Eastside Archery - Team Rules and Code of Conduct**

The following team rules are in supplement to all rules and policies included in district or school handbooks or policy documents.

- 1. Sports physicals and other required forms must be completed and turned in **before** a student may try out.
- 2. Archers must be in good academic standing (passing all classes) to participate in competitive tournaments.
- 3. Electronic devices (e.g., cell phones, iPods, games, etc.) are **NOT** allowed to be in use during practice.
- 4. Cheating will <u>NOT</u> be tolerated. Any student caught cheating (at practice or in competition) will be immediately expelled from the team. Any student witnessing the cheating without reporting the cheating will also be immediately expelled from the team.
- 5. Archers are expected to:
  - A. Take direction from the coaches and be open for change and new ideas to improve their skills
  - B. Adhere to all safety policies and whistle commands
  - C. Follow all NASP and range rules
  - D. Respect coaches, teammates, opponents, officials, spectators, and school property. No archer shall give negative comments about other teams, fellow teammates, opponent teammates, officials, coaches or opponent's coaches
  - E. Exhibit good sportsmanship; refrain from verbal threats, teasing, fighting, bullying, and any form of harassment
  - F. Attend all practices and tournaments <u>unless excused by the coach</u>
  - G. Arrive for practice far enough in advance to be ready and on the line at start time
  - H. Assist with gym set up at the start of practice and clean up at the end of practice. No one leaves the gym at the end of practice until all equipment has been properly stored.
  - I. Arrive for tournaments <u>at least</u> 30 minutes in advance of their flight time and check in with the coach immediately upon their arrival
- 6. Archers are to be picked up promptly when practices or tournaments are over. Archers will not wait for rides alone or in what is considered unsafe locations, before or after practices or tournaments.
- 7. No archer shall leave the gym during practices or tournaments without permission from a coach. This includes drink or restroom breaks during practices.
- 8. Archers are required to wear appropriate clothing to practice clothing that is not allowed in school is not allowed at practice. Necklaces, long earrings and loose fitting clothes are not acceptable. Closed toe shoes are **MANDATORY**.
- 9. One or more detentions in a school week may result in suspension from a tournament. Repeated detentions may result in suspension from the team.
- 10. Archers must have a "C" or higher in all classes to participate in practices & tournaments. Students will bring a student grade sheet around weekly to monitor behavior and grades in school.
- 11. Food, gum, and open drink containers are not allowed during practice. (Water is acceptable)

Any student who breaches the letter or intent of the rules will be subject to consequences as determined by the coaches, which could include suspension from a tournament or suspension from the team.
